The role does vary, but commonly, the Cath Lab nurse assists the Cardiac Interventionist in performing diagnostic and therapeutic percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI) on patients with heart disease and defects. PCI helps to diagnose and treat myocardial infarction and typically includes placing stents to coronary arteries.

### **How to Become a Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory Nurse ...**

Patients with COVID-19 or suspected COVID-19 requiring intubation should be intubated prior to arrival to the catheterization laboratory. Furthermore, the threshold to consider intubation in a patient with borderline respiratory status may need to be lowered to avoid emergent intubation in the catheterization laboratory.
