However, the Chicago Manual of Style recommends that for the sake of clarity writers are more cautious about using shortened citations (see above). To format your endnotes, add the title "Notes." If you're working with a longer document, you can add section headings as well (e.g., "Chapter 5" or "Chapter 5: The Wedding from Hell").

Footnotes and Endnotes | Chicago Manual of Style, 17th edition, personal communications, such as letters, e-mails, text messages, and phone calls are usually referenced in the footnotes and endnotes or explained in the text of the paper. They are rarely listed in the Chicago style bibliography.

Author-Date citations are more commonly used in the sciences and social sciences, while the NB style is more standard for works in the arts, history, and humanities.
