On 10 April 1980, a conference with diplomats from sixty-two States approved a set of rules providing a uniform law for international sales of goods. By December 1986, the treaty was ratified by eleven States (Argentina, China, Egypt, France, Hungary, Italy, Lesotho, Syrian Arab Republic, United States of America, Yugoslavia and Zambia).
