Although a power chord consists of only two different notes that are always five steps apart, such as A-E or C-G, the actual chord that you play may involve more than two strings, because you may be doubling each of the notes that make up the power chord. Power chords come in two varieties: Open-position: The following figure shows the most common open-position

How to Play Power Chords on Guitar - dummies

In essence, a power chord is a two note chord that is neither major nor minor. Savvy music theorists will note that this is

because it only consists of the root and fifth notes of a given chord. Since the third is what determines if a chord is major or minor, power chords remain neutral.

In their purest form power chords are made up of just two notes. The first is the “root”

note, which gives the power chord its name. The second is the “fifth” note. This is the note that’s a perfect interval of 5 above the root note.

For our purposes, a “power chord” is usually a 2- or 3-note chord played on the bass strings, and made

up only of roots and fifths. This is an important point, because that means it leaves out the note that makes a chord major or minor.

A power chord is a two-note chord, with no major or minor quality to it. This is because power chords are just made up of the root

and the fifth of the chord. The third of the chord, the part that usually gives the chord a major or minor quality, is left out of power chords. Don't worry too much about the theory behind this though.

Power chords are often referred to as a "fifth" or "5" chord. If you see

a chord written as C5, it is a C power chord. You can optionally omit the pinky finger, and play a power chord as a two-note chord. Most guitarists stick with the 3-note version, as they sound more full.

Power chords are common in heavy music, as well as many other musical styles. The power chord is also called 5 chord (E5, A5 etc) or slash chord.

Theoretically it's a major OR minor chord, where we have removed a note - the so called "3rd" (don't worry if you don't understand this). Probably the most common type of chord in rock/metal music
