In literature, authors like Byron, Scott, Wordsworth and Goethe led the way. In the musical world, composers such as Weber, Schubert, Schumann, Chopin, Liszt, Berlioz and Wagner were heavyweights of Romantic period music. (Note: Beethoven is often seen as the link composer between the Classical and Romantic periods.
